Anjou, young vines, oceanic climate. Spontaneous fermentations (alcoolic and malo). Cold settling. Light fitration before bottling. No disgorging.

An effervescent beauty of a pét-nat from native Loire grapes Grolleau Gris and Pineau d'Aunis, expertly crafted by young winemaker Pauline Lair in her urban winery in Angers.
