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PRODUCER

The Eschenhof Holzer winery is located in Großriedenthal, in the Wagram wine region. On the ~19 hectare estate, the innovative wine maker, Arnold Holzer, draws on the unique bounty of nature, with a great deal of creativity, a distinctive style and a sense for delicious creations.

VITICULTURE + VINIFICATION

A hill with deep reaching layers of rock, covered by red gravel and Loess layers. The southern slope is an especially warm location. Because of the rather barren ground, as compared to other vineyards, this soil is better suited for growth-intensive and rich sorts, like the Roter Veltliner. Additionally the grounds are also home to some fantastic red wines. Direct pressing, clarification, and fermented all done in stainless steel. No malo used. no

TASTING NOTE

The Wagram is the region of origin for Roter Veltliner. The taste of white wines from this red(dish) grape variety is unique through its variety of fruits, rich essence and full, spicy finish. The typical hint of honey notes grants the Roter Veltliner its complex nature — all in all, a chameleon among wines.
