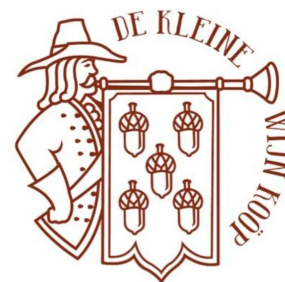


PRODUCER

De Kleine Wijn Koöp (the little wine co-op) started out as just a few good okses making awesome wines with cool labels, calling in winemaker friends to make each very limited batch cuvée. Now in the talented hands of winemaker Wynand Grobler, the range has gained greater focus and direction without losing any of the original irreverence and adventure. Given Wynand's experience in the valley, Franschhoek is becoming a bit of a calling card but like in the past the "little co-op" spreads its net far and wide seeking out great grapes across the beautiful and varied terroirs of the Cape winelands.



VITICULTURE + VINIFICATION

Syrah from Walker bay area (cool climate), Cinsault from Agter Paarl area (warm climate). Soils are decomposed Granite & shale mix. Each vine's grapes were harvested by hand in the early hours of the morning to capture the fresh fruit flavours. The bunches were sorted and fermentation took place in stainless steel- and cement tanks and 50% whole-bunch fermented before spending time on the lees in order to build a full, well-rounded palate. The varietals were vinified individually before blending. Natural malolactic fermentation occurs. No oak is used.

TASTING NOTE

Klipkers, the rare native tree that settles under the granite rocks in the wine country's mountain ranges, is the inspiration for the wine. Wherever you run into him you are surrounded by Proteas while the smell of fynbos fills your nostrils. Klipkers the wine has an aroma of fynbos, red currant and raspberry. The palate offers fresh red fruit, plum, white pepper and spice, a medium to full-bodied mouthfeel.
