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PRODUCER

Winerie Parisienne, the first wine producer and professional vineyard in Paris modern history has been a hit in the French Capital with its creative blends and striking identity. The current line-up from Winerie Parisienne include wines that have been made in Paris by sourcing grapes from top vineyards across France, all harvested by hand. It has also planted the first professional vineyard for 100 years (25 acres) in the Paris region (near Chateau de Versailles), under supervision of J. Brustis, a former oenologist at Chateau Angélu.



WINERIE PARISIENNE

VITICULTURE + VINIFICATION

Plots of Vermentino located in Provence on chalky clay soils. Harvested after optimum aromatic maturity is reached. Vines of 15 years old are farmed sympathetically with local agriculture. Harvesting takes place at night to preserve the aroma and avoid oxidation. Slow and progressive, cold direct pressing.. Part of the grape juice is kept at low temperature until bottling where it is used for tirage. The fermentation takes place in stainless steel tanks between 14 and 16 °C on fine lees. After several weeks of lees stirring, the wine is bottled with the grape juice kept cold. Secondary fermentation takes place in bottle from the natural sugar of the grape juice. Thus, a fine mousse appears and highlights the typicity of Vermentino. The wine is kept on lees for four months before disgorgement. Malolactic fermentation is completed. No oak is used.

TASTING NOTE

Don Paris, Rebellious yet elegant since 1899. the wine is named after Done Paris Peroni, and emblematic figure from Corsica. Born in a winegrower family in 1847, he was a winemaker in the Southern part of the nature reserve of Corsica. His sparkling wine, made from Vermentino, was well-known for its finesse and freshness. Adrien Pelissié, his 4th generation descendant, creates a Winerie Parisienne tribute to Don Paris Peroni with an exceptional Blanc de Blancs. Bold and classy. TASTING NOTES An intense aroma of orchids transports the drinker, couple with white peach and pear flavors which is signature of this expression of vermentino The finish gives just a hint of green almond. PARIS IS A PARTY!
