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PRODUCER

De Kleine Wijn Koöp (the little wine co-op) started out as just a few good okes making awesome wines with cool labels, calling in winemaker friends to make each very limited batch cuvée. Now in the talented hands of winemaker Wynand Grobler, the range has gained greater focus and direction without losing any of the original irreverence and adventure. Given Wynand's experience in the valley, Franschhoek is becoming a bit of a calling card but like in the past the "little co-op" spreads its net far and wide seeking out great grapes across the beautiful and varied terroirs of the Cape winelands.



VITICULTURE + VINIFICATION

An old Stellenbosch vineyard planted in 1952. Second oldest, low-yielding Cinsault bushvines, planted in 1952 in Stellenbosch. Grapes are picked by hand in the early morning hours to ensure that the flavours stay intact and that the best bunches are selected for ripeness. Whole-bunch fermentation took place in open-top fermenters with 2 punch-downs daily for 6 days. Natural malolactic fermentation occurs. After basket press, the wine was aged in two older 5001 French Oak barrels for 12 months.

TASTING NOTE

Perfumed and complex, it's a beautiful expression of this now in-vogue workhorse variety.
