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PRODUCER

Riesling and Pinot Noir are the stars of our winery. With these grape varieties we show the specific characteristics of world-famous terroirs like HÖLLENBERG, BERG SCHLOSSBERG, BERG ROTTLAND, BERG ROSENECK, BAIKEN and MARCOBRUNN with highest quality standards. With a philosophy of ecological cultivation we uncover the deeply hidden secrets of the vineyards. This potential can be fully realised in the cellar.

VITICULTURE + VINIFICATION

The Rheingau is one of the most distinguished wine regions of the world. Moving from east to west, the fairly flat, dimpled landscape evolves into progressively steep slopes. Mild winters and warm summers; the vineyards are protected from cold winds by the forest-capped Taunus Hills and benefit from the heat-reflecting surface of the Rhine. Rheingau is not only only Riesling. Pinot Noir finds some of the worlds most interesting plots to grow in the Rheingau. Our Rheingau Pinot Noir comes from different single vineyards combining their quartzite and loam soils. Grapes are carefully selected and picked by hand. Cold maceration, basket pressing, natural settling, lees contact and small batches are fermented in open top oak barrel fermenters. Malolactic fermentation is used to soften acidity, round the palate and balance the wine.

TASTING NOTE

A distinctly burgundian scent rises from this wine. The characteristics are filleted out in this Pinot Noir: razor sharp, juicy and sinewy the finish is long and lasting till the end with full force. A modern Pinot from the Rheingau, dynamic from attack to finale.
