PRODUCER

For four generations now, the Frey winery is located in the heart of the village Ober-Flörsheim, the highest elevated municipality in south-western Rheinhessen. Philipp and Christopher Frey, the youngest generation of the family are now in charge to operate the winery, beginning from the vineyard to the bottling. Since 2013 the grape-growing follows the EU-guidelines for organic viticulture. Near-natural fermentation, initiated by yeast from the vineyard and ageing oak barrels, barriques and stainless steel characterise the wines. The estate grown wines are organically farmed.

VITICULTURE + VINIFICATION

Grapes are hand harvested from vineyards that are farmed organically. The Reinhessen is one of Germany's arid regions (annual rainfall of just 500mm) The region is protected by the Palatinate mountains, protecting it from humid winds and storms. The grapes undergo a cold maceration of 12 hours. Fermentation in stainless steel tank is spontaneous with ambient yeasts. No.

TASTING NOTE

Fully Floral with an elegant nose and easy going demeanour. Vibrant and racy, this wine pairs well with mild cheese and fresh seafood dishes. Fresh apple, pear, and citrus notes.
